Principal's Message

State law says that all children under the age of 16 must wear a helmet while riding a bicycle. At BCE, we support this law by allowing only children who have helmets to bring their bicycles on campus. Children who arrive without helmets will not be allowed to ride their bikes from campus until they are wearing protective head gear.

Unlike walkers who are told to walk against traffic, state law says that bicyclists should travel with the flow of traffic on the right hand side of the road.

Common sense rules to bicycling also apply while students are on the way to or from school; only one person per bicycle, no tricks. Finally, all students should walk their bicycles on campus for the safety of all children and adults.

The FCAT season opens this month with the grade 4 writing test. This will require students in all grade 4 classes to write about a topic assigned in the testing booklet. The students will have 45 total minutes to plan, write and edit their story. The writing is then sent to Tallahassee for scoring on a scale of zero to six.

We have been preparing our students for this test all year, so there is no need for them to study. We do ask, however, that students do the following:

- Get plenty of rest;
- Get to school on time;
- Have a good breakfast (available free at school)

The Parent Internet Viewer

Look at your child's grades on line!

What is it?

The Parent Internet Viewer (PIV) is a resource that parents can use to keep up with their children's grades. It is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week through the internet. This service is available for students in grades 1 - 5.

How do I get there?

Go to the Boggy Creek Elementary School website at <http://www.bce.osceola.k12.fl.us>. In the links bar on the left side of the page, there is a link for the Parent Internet Viewer. Click that link. You will be taken to the PIV site.

How do I get in?

- Pull down on the school selection menu to Boggy Creek Elementary
- Enter your child's student id number - which is printed on all report cards and progress reports - in the User Name box.
- Enter your child's month and day of birth in the Password box - two digits for month, two for day. (December 14 = 1214)
- Click logon.

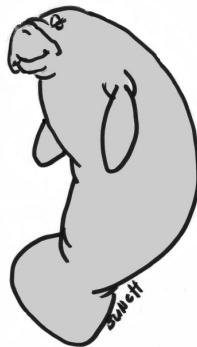

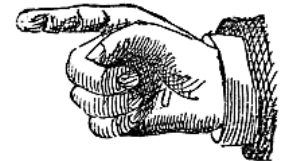
